President Olson called the meeting to order at 2:03 pm.

Treasurer's Report

The purchasing of cd ladders are complete. Every three months one water account cd will mature and every six months one HOA account cd will mature and will be reinvested.

As of May 13, there are three unpaid water bills.

There is one cd at Olympia Federal which will be moved over to WSECU when it matures in February 2021.

Finance Committee

Julie Corwin has volunteered to be chair of the Finance Committee for this year.

Water Committee

The Water System Log for the May meeting is attached.

Locates will begin the week of May 18th for the Valve Replacement Project, and digging will start Tuesday after Memorial Day. Boil water advisories will be sent out when applicable.

Water Usage

All water meter readings were recorded on May 1st. April water usage was as follows:

- 968,900 gal, ~3.0 acre-ft. (March 2020 489,500 gal, April 2019 566,850 gal) 32,300 gal. per day.
- ~363 gal. per day per household.
- The average household used 10,697 gal., with 12 households using greater than 21,400 gal. (~2X the average) during the month.
- System leakage was 0.9% for the month.

Maintenance

- Completed monthly maintenance.
- Completed 2nd quarter maintenance.
- Completed annual maintenance for April.
- Restored island sprinkler systems from winter layup.

Other

Buried distribution valve replacement has been delayed due to statewide work restrictions. The planned work is now scheduled to begin the week of May 18.

Secretary's Report

The 4th of July neighborhood picnic is still planned for Saturday, the 4th. However, logistics may have to be adjusted to be socially safe. The board will keep everyone up-to-date.
